## Certificates and Documents issued by the Republic of Liberia

July 29, 2011

### To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to confirm that, on October 2, 2006, the Liberian Administration started issuing maritime certificates and documents that are printed with the signature and stamp of the Liberian Deputy Commissioner, the Republic of Liberia and that correspond in form to the models given in SOLAS, MARPOL and other relevant conventions. The Liberian Deputy Commissioner has duly authorized that their signature and stamp may be printed on the certificates and documents issued by the Liberian Administration. The certificates and documents also contain, within the background, the seal of the Republic of Liberia. These certificates and documents with printed signature and seal shall at all times be considered valid as original. The certificates are also issued in accordance with Section 20 of the Maritime Law relating to Chapter 13 of Title 14 of the (Liberian Codes Revised) Electronic Transactions Law and shall be carried on board Liberian registered ships in accordance with applicable regulations. If necessary, authenticity of certificates may be confirmed as provided below.\*

These hard copy original certificates and documents issued by the Liberian Administration include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Certificates of Registry
- Minimum Safe Manning Certificates
- Radio Licenses
- Continuous Synopsis Records
- International Safety Management Certificates
- International Ship Security Certificates
- Civil Liability Convention Certificates
- Maritime Labour Convention Certificates

The certificates and documents may be transmitted by regular surface mail or electronically and are protected from alteration or tampering. The date of issuance and expiration may be typed or hand written at the time of issuance by an authorized Liberian Inspector, Auditor or Special Agent of the Deputy Commissioner. Therefore, certificates and documents dated and transmitted theretofore and that are printed in color and are on board the vessel shall also be considered valid as original.

This letter is to be kept with the vessel's certificates and documents and made available to interested Port State Control, Classification Society surveyors and auditors.
