SUBJECT: Guidance on implementation of MARPOL Annex VI 2020 Global Sulphur Limit

Dear Shipowner/Operator/Master/Recognized Organizations:

The purpose of this Advisory is to provide guidance regarding implementation of the global sulphur limit which takes effect on 1 January 2020.

From 1 January 2020, the limit for sulphur in fuel oil used on board ships operating outside designated emission control areas (ECA) will be reduced from 3.50% m/m to 0.50% m/m (mass by mass) and the Sulphur content of any fuel oil carried for use on board ships when operating outside designated emission control areas, shall not exceed 0.50% m/m on and after 1 March 2020.

Over the last twelve months the Liberian Administration has been responding to numerous questions related to preparation, implementation, operation and enforcement, including Exhaust Gas Cleaning System (EGCS).
